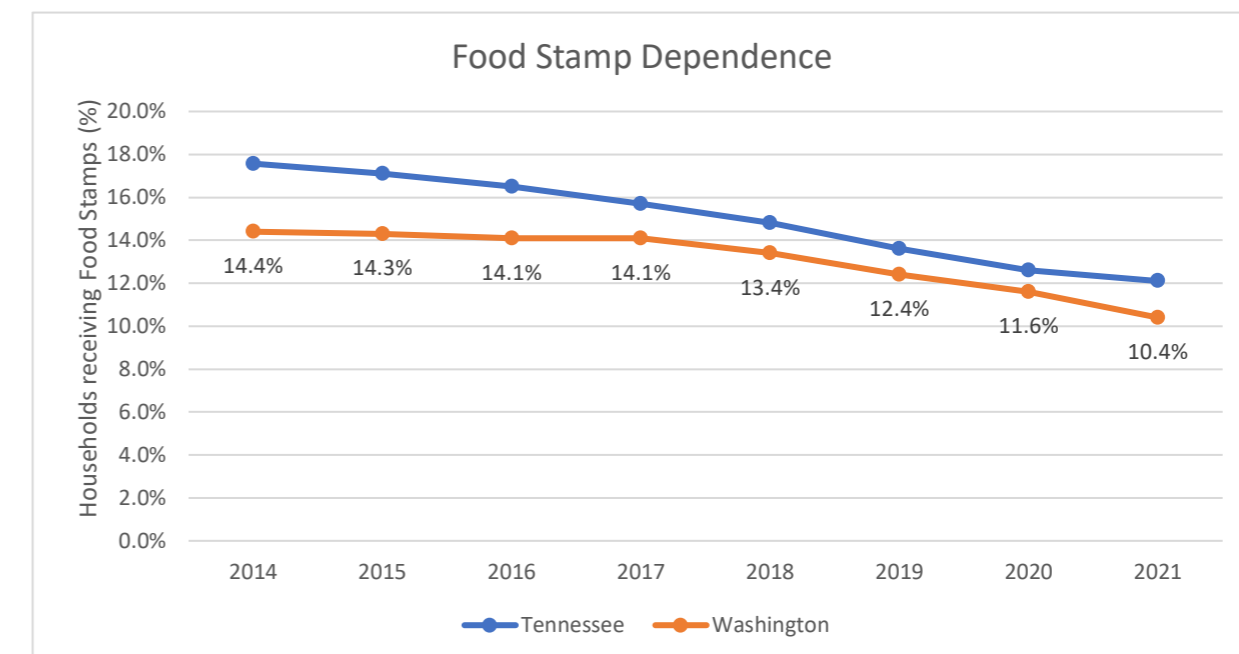
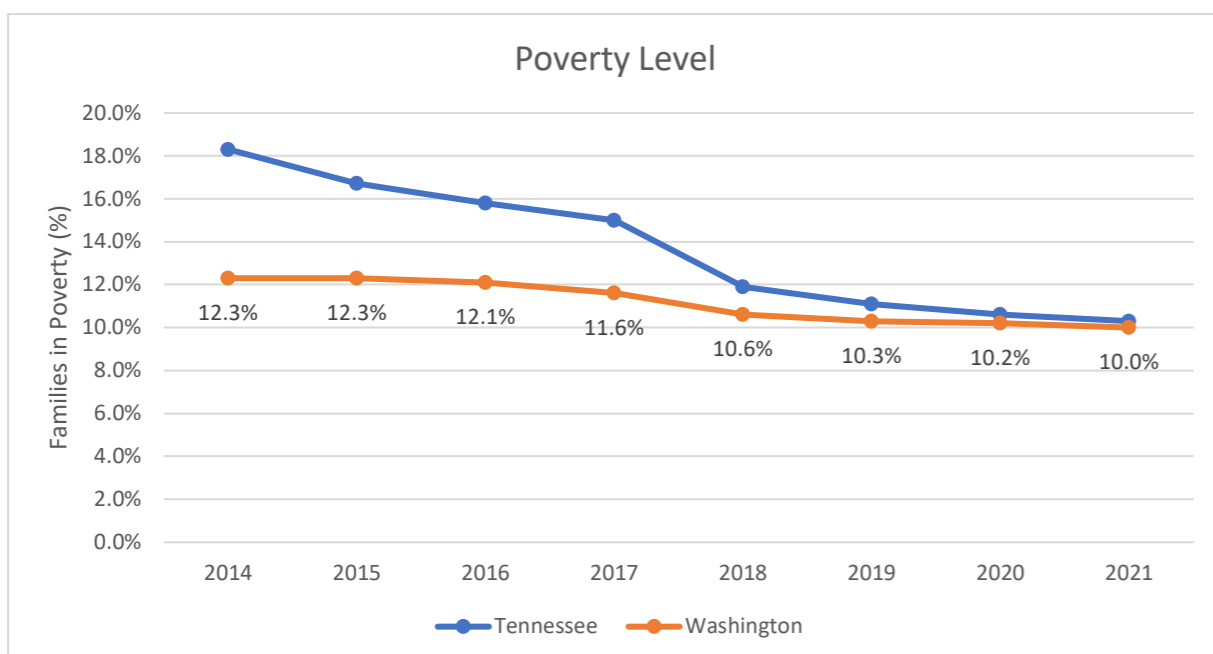
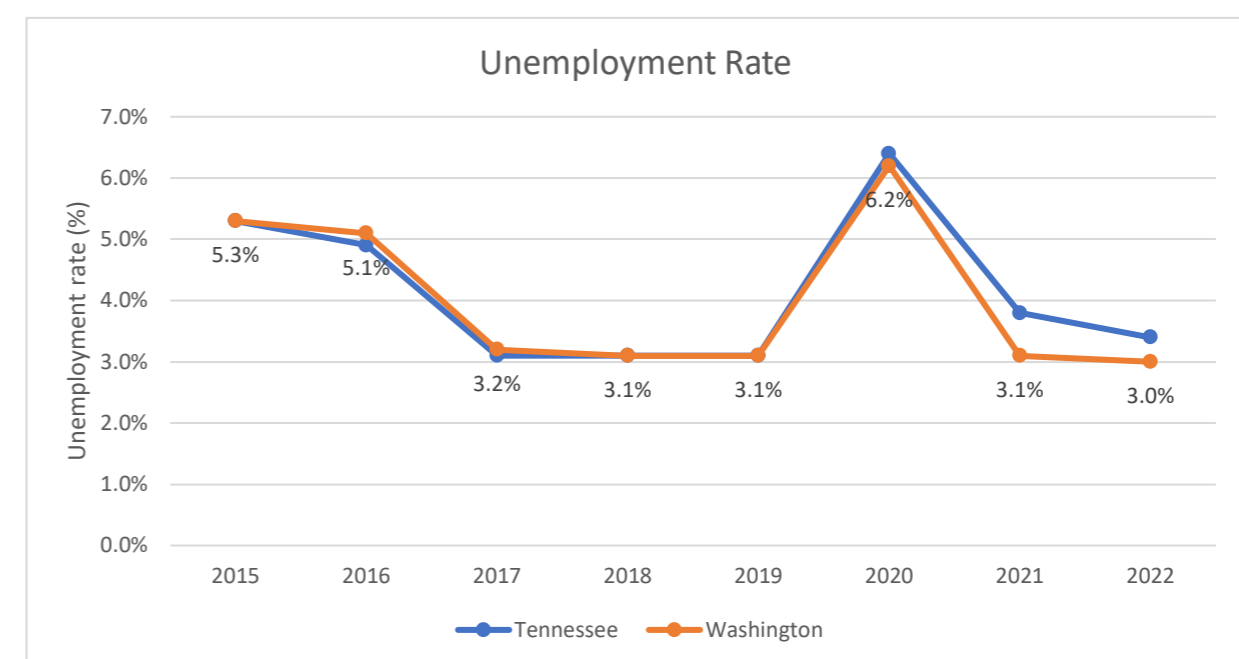
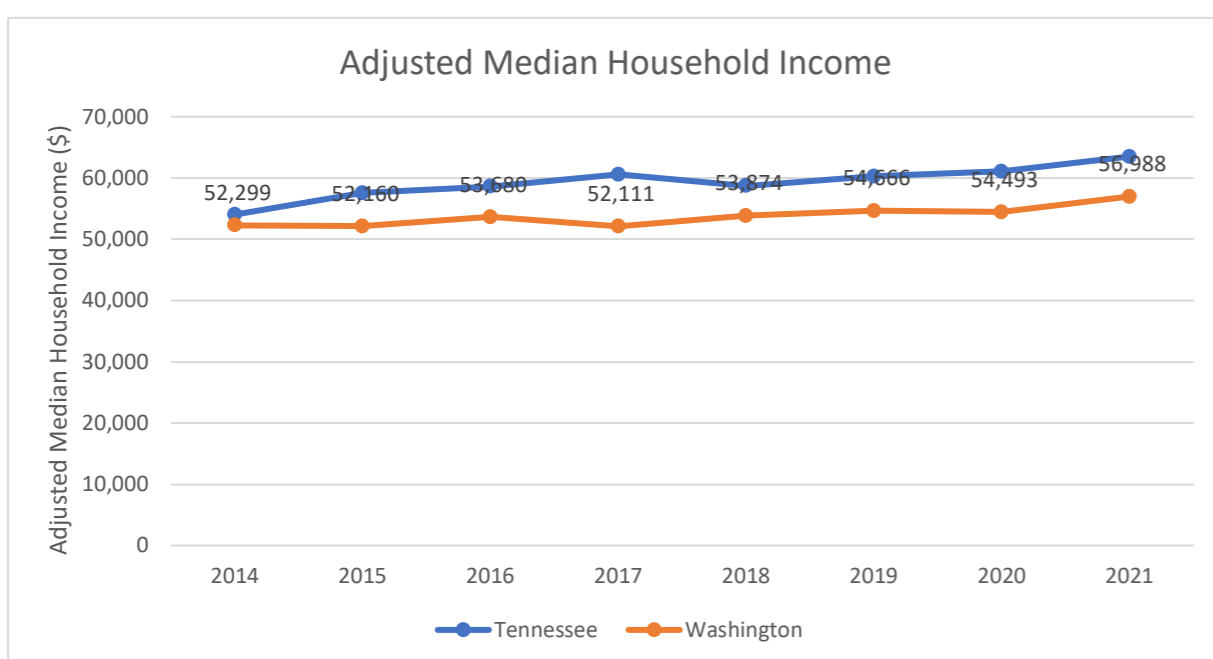
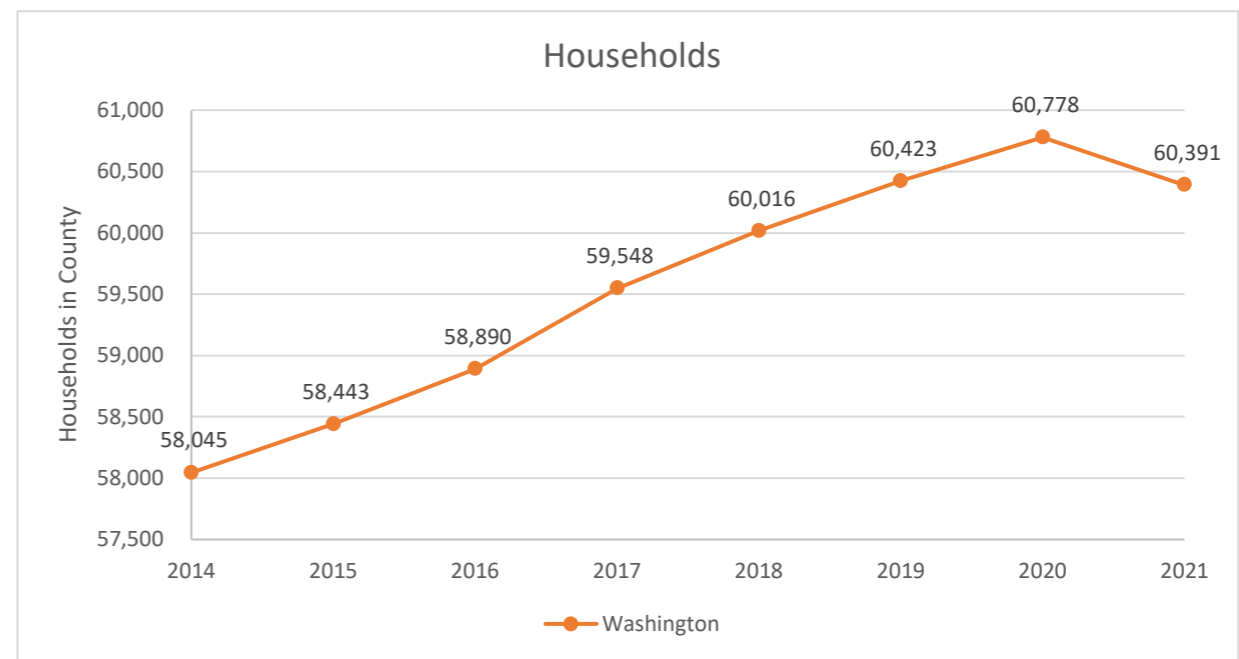
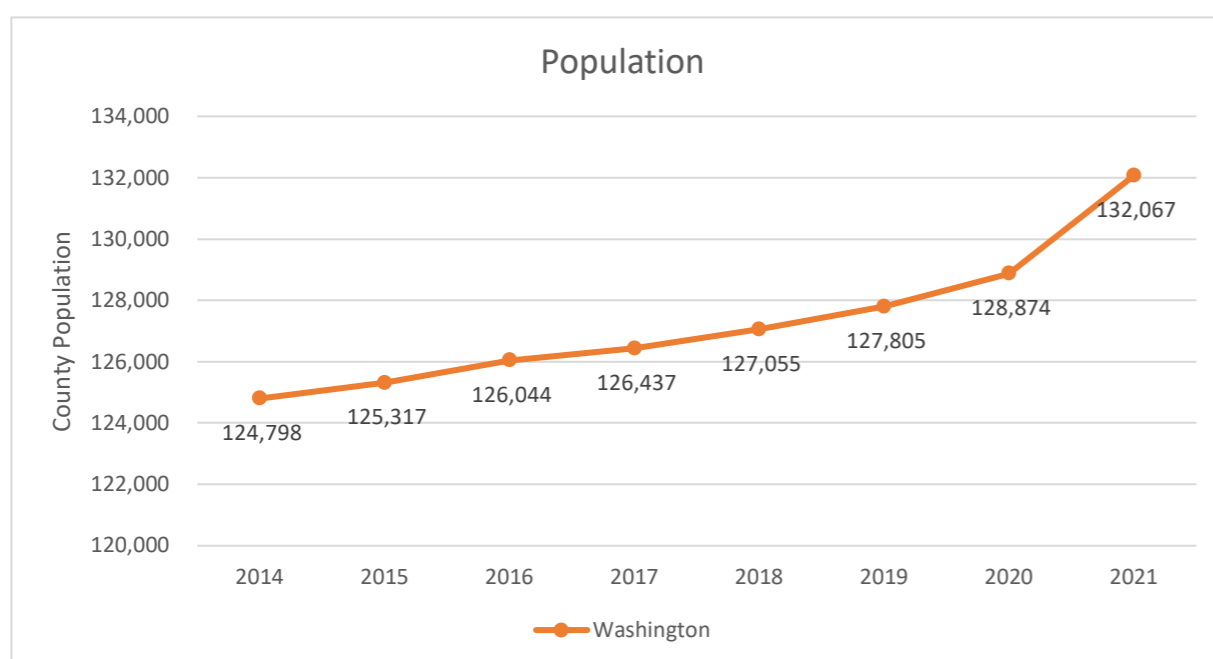

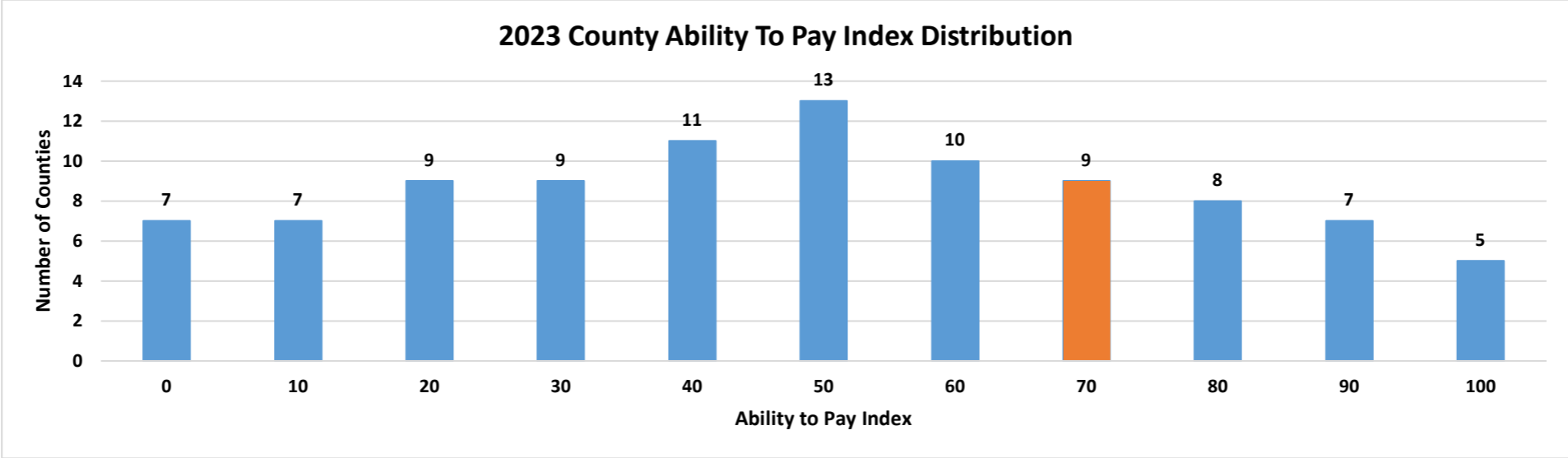
Ability to Pay Index
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The population and household trend charts demonstrate the changes over time at the County level. Median household income, unemployment rate, poverty level and food stamp dependence trends over time are presented for the County and Tennessee.



The Ability to Pay Index distribution provides an overview of the number of counties that fall in the range from 0 to 100. An Ability to Pay Index of 0 indicates an economically distressed community and that of a 100 indicates a relatively wealthy community. The County specific Ability To Pay Index is highlighted in Orange.
